**Introduction:** The Interdepartmental Science Students' Society is an inclusive and transparent science faculty association existing to offer useful services, to connect its diverse membership, and to advocate so that science students may enjoy an enriching and valuable undergraduate experience.

In order to engage a wider audience in the affairs of the ISSS, Executives have the authority to delegate parts of their portfolio to Members. A Director is responsible for a specific task that falls under an Executive's portfolio, and should work closely with the Executive to ensure the smooth operation of that project.
